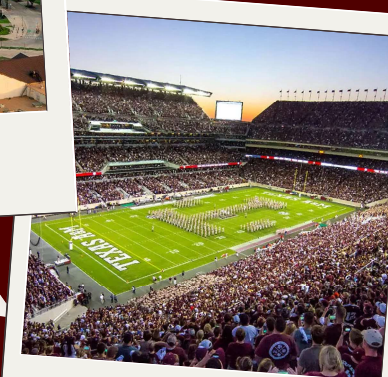

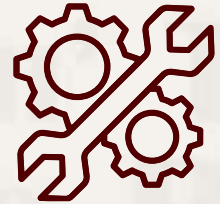

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Interns will be assigned to a faculty mentor and research team, with about 40–45 hours per week of engagement. The normal business hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., with a one-hour lunch break, but this schedule may vary depending on the faculty mentor and the lab where you are placed



Texas A&M will arrange housing in College Station apartments near campus, but students are responsible for paying the costs - apartment will be on the bus route

You need to arrive at IAH Airport, about one hour from College Station, and take a shuttle from there. If you arrive within the designated arrival period, the shuttle to College Station is provided at no cost, but if you choose to arrive earlier on your own, you will be responsible for the transportation costs



Students are expected to secure their own health insurance coverage for the duration of the program

Texas A&M has a huge campus, but there are free buses available to help you get around.
